**A**

1-4: All go up a double and back.

5-8: All do two changes of rights and lefts, starting with partner.

9-12: All go down a double and back.

13-16: All do two changes of rights and lefts, starting with partner.

**B**

1-4: All star by the right.

5-8: All star by the left.

9-12: First woman and second man start a chevron by passing left shoulders, then backing up, while the first man and second woman lead out and loop into progressed place.

13-16: All turn partner two hands.
