- A1**
- 1-4 Rights & lefts (4 changes, start partner right)
 - 5 Ladies cross (pass right)
 - 6 Men cross (pass right)
 - 7 Ladies cross back (pass right)
 - 8 Men cross back (pass right)
- A2**
- 1-2 1s gate 2s (up and around)
 - 3-4 Partner two-hand turn $\frac{1}{2}$
 - 5-6 2s gate 1s (down and around)
 - 7-8 Partner two-hand turn $\frac{1}{2}$
- B1**
- 1-2 1s lead down and cast back up
 - 3-4 Partner two-hand turn $\frac{1}{2}$
 - 5-6 2s lead up and cast back down
 - 7-8 Partner two-hand turn $\frac{1}{2}$
- B2**
- 1-6 Double figure eight (quick, 1s cross down, 2s cast up, to start)
 - 7 Partner meet & fall back
 - 8 Neighbor pass right
