Notes:

- 1) Written for the Surrey Dog Training Club and debuted on September 13, 1980. Barbara Woodhouse was a well known British dog trainer, author and television personality. Her 1980 television series Training Dogs the Woodhouse Way made her into a household name in the UK. Among her catch-phrases were "walkies" and "sit!". If only the dancers were as well behaved!
- 2) To "woof" is to make a canine noise.

Dance:

- A1 1-4 Middle couple cross over, cast left into the center of head lines
5-8 Balance in lines (*onto left foot first*)
- A2 1-4 Middle couple cross over, cast right into the center of side lines
5-8 Balance in lines (*onto left foot first*)
- B1 1-4 Partner back-to-back
5 All "woof woof"
6-8 Top couple chasée to the bottom (*others move up*)
- B2 1-4 Partner back-to-back
5 All "woof woof"
6-8 Top couple chasée to the bottom (*others move up*)
