Progression: 4 place, men counter-clockwise, ladies clockwise
Music: 32-bar jigs and reels

Notes:

- 1) A seesaw is a back-to-back passing left shoulders first.
- 2) All the passes in B1 and B2 are by the right shoulder.
- 3) Written Dec 22, 1981 at (and debuted in) Old Brun's Farm barn, Wendover, Buckinghamshire, UK.

Dance:

A1	1-4	Partner back-to-back
	5-8	Partner chasée into the center & out
A2	1-4	Partner see-saw
	5-8	Partner chasée into the center & out
B1	1-2	Partner clap hands, own hands, right hands, own hands, left hands
	3-4	Pass partner (<i>right shoulder, face the next</i>)
	5-8	Repeat
B2	1-4	Repeat
	5-8	Repeat
